Why the Smartest Among Us Do the Dumbest Things

"If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross and follow me. For

whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me and for the gospel will save it. What good is it for a man to gain the whole world, yet forfeit his soul? Or what can a man give in exchange for his soul? If anyone is ashamed of me and my words in this adulterous and sinful generation, the Son of Man will be ashamed of him when he comes in his Father's glory with the holy angels." – Mark 8:34b-38

Steven Hawking was born in Oxford, England in early1942 and went on to his reward on March 14, 2018. He was laid to rest on Saturday, March 31, 2018, in Cambridge, England. Private services were held for him at the university's church, Mary the Great. Many people offered their tributes and praises of him. Even the Queen of England sent her respects for the passing of such a great human being.

As an interesting bit of trivia, Stephen Hawking was born on January 8, 1942. This is 300 years, to the day, after the death of the father of modern science, Galileo Galilei. And similarly, he died precisely on the 139th anniversary of the birth of Albert Einstein.

Stephen Hawking began his research on cosmology at Cambridge in 1962. One year later, he was diagnosed with ALS. It was not long until he would be confined to a wheelchair for the rest of his life. Even so, in 1965, from that chair, he would gain his PhD in the study of an expanding universe.

For 76 years of human life, Stephen Hawking's name became known world-wide. His accomplishments were such that he was appointed Professor of Mathematics at Cambridge, a post held by Sir Isaac Newton. Prof. Hawking's ashes will be interred in Westminster Abbey, next to Isaac Newton's. Perhaps best known for using Albert Einstein's general theory of relativity to "mathematically" walk time back to the point of the "BIG BANG".

All these wonderful and amazing accomplishments for one person spending most of his adult life with such a debilitating horror as ALS. I cannot imagine living with such a mind as his, fully intact while his body continually deteriorates. With everything he had to suffer and endure, few can say that he was not a great human being. Our world is a far better place because Stephen Hawking was in it.

Even so, he has said some very troubling things about his doubts and disbelief of God's existence. He is not alone on this denial of our Creator God.

I pray for Stephen Hawking and all those other people who live and die without God. No matter their accomplishments in this world, eternally, they are lost souls.

Believers, at the end of our lives, we know that we have a place in a glory-filled eternity in heaven. Jesus promised us that much. What does the non-believer have? Anything?

I pray for Stephen Hawking because our understanding of God's creation, the cosmos, has been tremendously enhanced because of his work from his chair. Because of him, human

understanding of the heavens has been increased.

And, just as we humans have benefited because of Dr. Stephen Hawking, the wonders of heaven would be an even better place if Stephen were there.

For what is the value of a person's life and everything that person did in their life, if they lose it all because they cannot find God?
