PASTOR'S COLUMN August 2025

It is right for me to think this way about all of you, because you hold me in your heart, for all of you share in God's grace with me, both in my imprisonment and in the defense and confirmation of the gospel.

Philippians 1:7

Paul's Letter to the Philippians is one of my favorites. It's filled with a sense of warmth and love between Paul and the church he founded in Philippi. It is in part a thank you note from Paul to the Philippians for the money they sent to support him while in prison. While there are many moments in this letter that bear witness to that warmth and love, one of my favorites is the above:

"It is right for me to think this way about all of you, because you hold me in your heart."

Although most translations express this verse in the above way, it's also possible to translate it as "because I hold you in my heart." I very much like that both means are possible. It means there's "a whole lot of heart holding" going on!

By the time you read this, I'll be in the midst of a monthly-long European trip. Among the countries we'll be visiting is Switzerland, the ancestral home of many of you. I may even walk the streets where your ancestors walked many years ago! I'm not scheduled to return to Immanuel until September 14.

However, it's possible that July 13 was my last Sunday with you. At the time I wrote this, your search committee appeared to be close to naming a candidate that they would recommend to you as your next called pastor.

If that happens. I'll be glad for you, since that's been the focus of my ministry—to help bridge the gap and prepare you to receive your new pastor. But I'll feel just a bit sad, since I won't be able to be with you anymore. Like Paul, I hold you—and WILL hold you—in my heart. And I know you'll be doing the same for me. As I said a few paragraphs ago, there's been "a whole lot of heart holding" going on!

Whatever the outcome, I know God will continue to richly bless you. I know that God will guide and empower the ministry of Immanuel, whatever form it takes. And I know that the love you've had for me and the love you have for each other will continue to grow.

Thanks be to God for all the blessings that shower down upon us!
